Financial Update - Chris Daigle

- Noting an increase in the club's financial position due to club registration money.

 - Square swipe cost is a lot, consider using PNC swipe.

 - 7 stipends and one free player for the club coaches during the 2025-2026 season.
 - Club Final Team Accounts
 - Reported on the financial status of various teams, noting past due accounts and accounting errors.

 - 2016 girls- finalizing
 - 2015 boys- finalizing
 - Discussed the need for teams to manage their financial obligations and the impact of unpaid accounts on the club's finances.
 - Emphasized the importance of accurate financial tracking and the need for teams to meet their financial responsibilities.
 - Highlighted the need for clear communication and enforcement of financial policies to ensure the club's financial stability.
- Discussed the need to raise rec.registration fees and rec. sponsorship fees to cover the costs of running the league.
 - Debated the optimal increase in registration fees and sponsorship fees, considering the financial impact on families.
 - Suggested a balanced approach to raising fees, considering the club's financial needs and the impact on families.

Club Update - Trish Bacon/ Colene Lowery/ Chris Daigle

- Provided an update on the club's teams for the 2025-2026 season, noting the registration status of coaches and team managers.
 - o 10 teams.
 - 103 roster players.
 - o Pool players have until the end of the month to register.
 - All but one coach is registered for the upcoming season.
 - o 2012 Black registered ASL.
 - 2012 girls registered level 2-3.
 - 2013/2014 boys team changed to 2012/2013 boys and 2014 only.
 - Awaiting on a few birth certificates
 - 16K fine noted if Birth certificates do not match.
- Discussed the need for team managers to register and the importance of accurate player information for registration.
 - o Missing one team manager 2014 boys: Angel's team.
 - Raichel Nutt considering.
 - Angels' team is short players on their roster.
- Highlighted the club's efforts to support teams and ensure they have the necessary resources for the season.
- Emphasized the importance of clear communication and coordination between coaches, team managers, and the club.
 - Coaches will receive more support and guidance with the help of a technical director, referee courses and feedback from the director of coaches.

- Highlighted the importance of clear communication and coordination between the club and other teams to avoid conflicts and ensure fair practices.
- Outlined the next steps for the club, including finalizing agreements with Spartans and ensuring clear communication with all stakeholders.

 - Logistics of opening day, including the need for a clear schedule and the importance of having uniforms ready for players reviewed.
 - Need for a clear communication plan to avoid confusion about opening day events discussed.
- Field Marshal Program- Board members need to register, advertise field marshal to anyone including coaches. Paid position.
 - Emphasized the importance of having trained Field Marshals to handle conflicts and ensure smooth operations.
 - Discussed the need for additional training for referees and the importance of having qualified referees for tournaments.
